

FEV TUTOR: Activating the Touch Screen Feature of the Platform

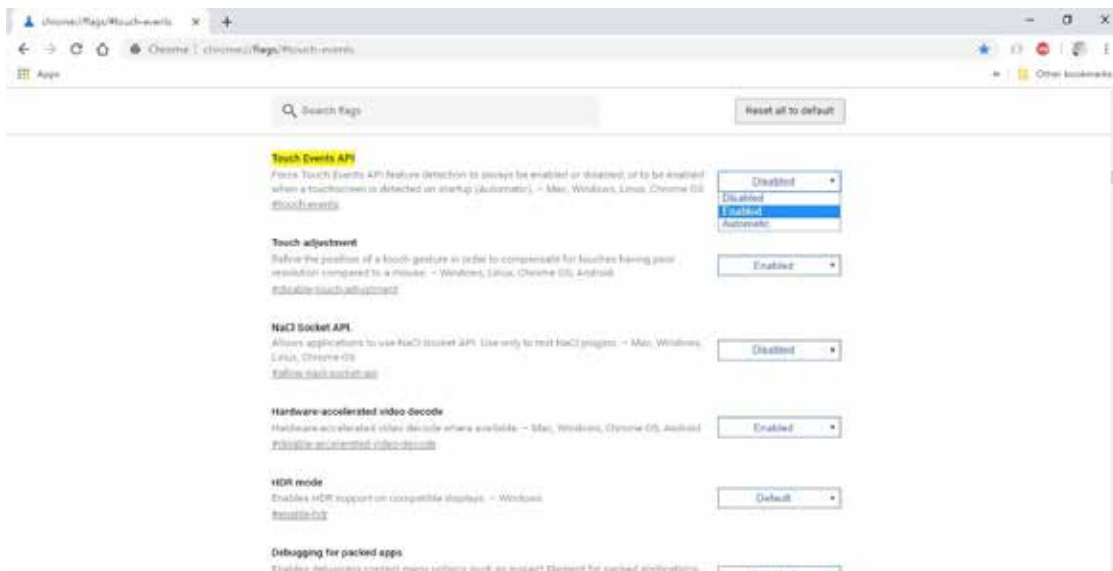
Devices that have a touch screen require an additional step in order to activate the capabilities of the touch screen on the FEV Tutor Platform.

Commonly Used Touch Screen Devices:

- Microsoft Surface & Surface Pro Devices
- Lenovo Thinkpad (Touch Screen)
- Chromebook (Touch Screen)
- Dell (Touch Screen)

Follow the below steps to ensure your devices are ready to go on your first day of tutoring!

1. Open the Google Chrome Browser.
2. Enter <chrome://flags/#touch-events> into the URL of the web browser.
3. Change the 'Touch event API' from **Disabled** to **Enabled**.



4. Click on the **'Relaunch Now'** button in the bottom-right corner to relaunch the web browser.
5. Login to www.fevtutor.com using a student account and request an 'On-Demand' session to see if the platform is now working with the touch screen.

Note: If you are using a Chromebook, you must log in as a registered user in order to enable the above browser settings. The process will not work if you are logged in as a Guest User. The application will still work without the touch screen by using a mouse and keyboard.
